




Cumulative returns (since inception, 12 August 2011)

Manager commentary

Volatility remained elevated in December as equity markets continued to fall sharply. We used this as an opportunity to increase equity holdings in the Portfolio towards the end of the month, as we had also done in early November. Valuations have improved materially in the past year, given prices have fallen while corporate earnings have generally increased, particularly in the US. We recognise the many risks in markets but believe that current valuations heavily discount many of these already and that increasing exposure to risk assets should enhance returns over time. The 1% increase in equity allocations was directed towards US orientated strategies and was funded by reducing holdings in liquid alternative strategies.
